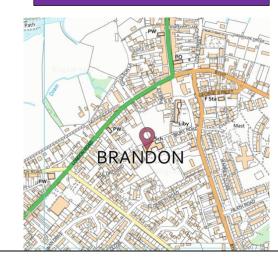

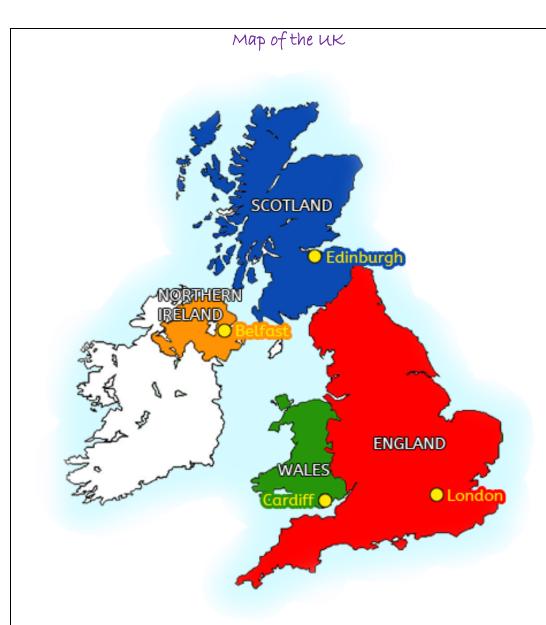

- Rule of Law: all people and groups are ruled by the same laws to keep us safe and happy.
- Mutual Respect and Tolerance: respecting all people whose faith and beliefs may be different from our own.
