

Key Stage 1—Are We Nearly There Yet?—Spring 2nd 2023



Immersion Day: The Rocket:

Children will learn about George Stephenson's first steam locomotive; The Rocket. They will create huge train tracks, make a train from the Playpod resources and write poems about what they can see from a 'Train' window!



Session 2: Science: Initial Assessment

LO: Assessing prior knowledge

Children to have an array of different objects to sort. Children to discuss what they think they may be made from.



Session 3: Science: Material Scavenger Hunt

LO: I am learning to identify and name a variety of everyday materials, including wood, plastic, glass, metal, water, and rock.

Children to go on a scavenger hunt to find a list of different materials. (Questioning)



Session 4: Science: Making Predictions.

LO: I am learning to compare and group together a variety of everyday materials on the basis of their simple physical properties.

Children to make predictions on what material would be the best for bedding for the Guinea Pigs. (Predicting)



Session 5: Science: Absorbency Experiment

LO: I am learning to set up and perform a simple test. Children to complete an experiment to test the absorbency of different materials. Children to record their results of their experiment. (Set up and perform)



Session 6: Science: Guinea Pig Bedding!

LO: I am learning to use my observations to suggest answers to questions. Using their learning from the previous simple test, the children will suggest a material that would be best suited for bedding for the Guinea Pigs. (Observations/Questioning)

LO: I am learning about an important Scientist and their work.

Session 8: History: Brandon Station.

LO: I am learning to use more than one type of source to find out about an event from the past.

Children finding out about the history of Brandon station and analyse a picture of the past.



Session 9: History: Brandon Station

LO: I am learning to use a source for information. I am learning to share what I found out by telling someone.

Children to make comparisons between Brandon station in the past and present.



Session 10: History: The first aeroplane flight.

LO: I am learning to sequence events using photographs and a simple timeline.

Children to look at the history of flight and will create a timeline to represent the evolution of flight over the years.



Session 11: History: Lakenheath airbase.

LO: I am learning to use a source for information.

Children to look at the new F35A planes, compared the first ever planes. Children to make comparisons and look at sources to learn about the history of the airbase in our locality. Share the Flight Tracker Maps around our locality.



Session 12: Art: Patterns and Printing.

LO: I am learning to use drawing and painting to share ideas and experiences.

Children to look at pattern and texture in their environment and find out how to record this in a visual way.



Session 13: Art: Practising Printing

LO: I am learning to develop a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern and texture.

Children to make repeated and rotated prints using different objects.



Session 14: Art: Jackson Pollock

LO: I am learning about the work of Jackson Pollock.

Children to use the wheels of toy cars to recreate a famous Jackson Pollock painting.
